Miss Plahé is currently employed by Keith Borer Consultants as a Forensic Scientist specialising in Imagery Analysis and Enhancement and Tachograph Route Tracing.

### EXPERIENCE AND EXPERTISE

Miss Plahé was awarded a Master of Biological Sciences degree with First Class honours and a Bachelor of Science degree with First Class honours from the University of Leeds. With this, she has two years of Imagery Analysis experience from previous employment as a Cellular Biologist, in which imagery, taken on a microscopic level, was examined for image quality and image content to determine the growth and health of mammalian cell lines in accordance with international pharmaceutical production regulations.

She joined Keith Borer Consultants in 2024 as a Forensic Scientist and specialises in the comparison of people and objects, analysis of events or actions, and post-capture editing and enhancements. Miss Plahé also undertakes report review and critical findings checks for peers in each of these areas. She has completed in house training and competency assessments underpinning the principles of imagery interpretation and analysis and the use of video software in a forensically safe manner and has completed a course at the Forensic Photography Symposium in the forensic use of Photoshop.

Miss Plahé has also undertaken training to specialise in the interpretation of tachograph data, in relation to the calibration and analysis of digital and analogue tachograph recording systems for their use in route tracing.
