Ms Gray has been employed as a forensic consultant since 2001 and is instructed in around 300 cases each year involving a range of alcohol and forensic chemistry casework, which includes murders, assaults and terrorist-related incidents. Alcohol casework includes back calculations, alcohol-related offences and the effects of alcohol on complainants and defendants. Chemistry casework includes gunshot residues, explosives, explosive devices and their manufacture, CS and PAVA incapacitants and fire investigations. She prepared reports in the cases of the failed London bombings (2005) and the murder of Rhys Jones in Liverpool (2007).

She is also responsible for the quality review of reports prepared by other experts at Keith Borer Consultants, totalling around 250 annually.
